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## 1-1 THE SIMPLE PRESENT AND THE PRESENT PROGRESSIVE.

THE SIMPLE PRESENT	<ul> <li>(a) Ann <i>takes</i> a shower every day.</li> <li>(b) I usually eat lunch at the cafeteria.</li> <li>(c) Babies <i>cry</i>.</li> <li>(d) The earth <i>revolves</i> around the sun.</li> <li>(e) A square <i>has</i> four equal sides.</li> <li>(f) The sky <i>is</i> blue.</li> </ul>	The simple present expresses daily habits or <b>usual activities</b> , as in (a) and (b). The simple present expresses <b>general</b> <b>statements of fact</b> , as in (c) and (d).
THE PRESENT PROGRESSIVE	<ul> <li>(g) Ann can't come to the phone right now because she <i>is taking</i> a shower.</li> <li>(h) It's noon. <i>I am eating</i> lunch at the cafeteria right now.</li> <li>(i) Jimmy and Susie are babies. They <i>are crying</i>. I can hear them right now. Maybe they are hungry.</li> </ul>	The present progressive expresses an activity that is in progress (is occurring, is happening) right now. FORM: am, is, are + -ing.

# 1-2 FORMS OF THE SIMPLE PRESENT AND PRESENT PROUGRESSIVE.

	SIMPLE PRESENT	PRESENT PROUGRESSIVE
STATEMENT:	(I-You-We-They) work. (He-She-It) works.	I am working. (You-We-They) are working. (He-She-It) is working.
NEGATIVE:	(I-You-We-They) do not work. (He-She-It) does not work.	I am not working. (You-We-They) are not working. (He-She-It) is not working.
QUESTION:	Do (I-You-We-They) work? Does (He-She-It) work?	AmIworking?Are (You-We-They) working?Is(He-She-It) working?

 $\checkmark$  Contractions of pronouns with be: I'm, you're, we're, they're, he's, she's, it's.

✓ Contractions of verbs with not: don't, doesn't, aren't, isn't.

NOTE Am and not are not contracted

These words refer to ( simple present tense):	<ul> <li>✓ always – usually – often – sometimes – seldom – rarely – never.</li> <li>✓ Everyday - Every (week, month, year) – Once a (week, month, year) - Twice a (day, week, month , year)—Three times a (day, week, month, year)</li> </ul>
These words refer to (present continuous tense):	✓ Now - Right now - At present - At the moment.

	QUESTION	SHORT ANSWER	LONG ANSWER
SIMPLE PRESENT	Does Bob like tea?	Yes, he does. No, he doesn't.	Yes, he likes tea. No, he doesn't like tea.
	Do you like tea?	Yes, I do. No, I don't.	Yes, I likes tea. No, I doesn't like tea.
PRESENT PRO- GRESSIVE	Are you studying?	Yes, I am. No, I'm not.	Yes, I am studying. No, I am not studying.
	Is Yoko studying?	Yes, she is. No, she's Not. OR: No, she isn't.	Yes, she is studying. No, she's not studying. OR: No, she isn't studying.
	Are they studying?	Yes, they are. No, they're not. OR: No, they aren't.	Yes, they're studying. No, they're not studying. OR: No, they aren't studying.

Note: (Am, is, and are) are not contracted with pronouns in short answers.

INCORRECT SHORT ANSWER: Yes, I'm. Yes, she's. Yes, they're.
